For the past month, I offer the following summary;

- Attended several CESA 12 meetings
 - monthly superintendent check in
 - discussion staffing turn over
 - staff climate survey
 - CESA 12 is hoping to purchase a newer/smaller building in Ashland
 - Nick Madison reviewed the process and need for 75% of the districts to approve
 - information on Jan.16 agenda
- The Bayfield County School Operations Planning meeting (Maria Renz and Meagan Quarderer) will be held in person at the School District of Bayfield in January.
 - All present will tour the building
 - · discussion of coordinated emergency response language and communication threads county wide
- Meeting with Jim Pete, Lac Courte Oreilles Ojibwe University
 - Interested in hosting an informational meeting for juniors and seniors at the outreach site in Red Cliff in January or February
 - he suggested 11:00-1:00 with a lunch

- BP will connect with Karla Vinci and Shellie Swanson on logistics
- Meetings with Red Cliff
 - DHS Opioid Abatement Funding
 - Discussion of Red Cliff's core strategies to address opioid remediation and abatement tactics.
 - The role the school could play in supporting youth education and mental health support/youth leadership education of opioid crisis
 - Ojibwemowin Meetings
 - Rosetta Stone individual use accounts purchased by the Tribe for employees and tribal members interested.
 - 160 employees interested
 - 200 tribal members said yes
 - Goal is to get people to use Rosetta Stone
 - BP asked if someone can come to the district to teach interested staff how to use Rosetta Stone–no updates
 - a smaller group has been tasked with working on community surveys/information sessions around the topic of Language Immersion educational programs and schools.
 - First meeting 1/11/23
 - stay tuned for updates
- Regular meetings and check ins with Athletic Director, Ron Borchers
- Meetings with Joe Donovan of the Donovan Group (<u>more info/website</u>) to discuss a communication audit and communication plan for the district in order to promote and provide comprehensive communication to all of our stakeholders
 - Goal is to create and launch a Communication Committee by the end of February made up of a few school board members, a member of the administration team, 3 teachers/staff, 3 parents, and 3 at large community members.
 - Donovan Group will share costs and timelines available to launch a communication plan for the 23-24 school year
 - What are the district's internal and external communication goals?
 - Who are the stakeholders we need to reach?
 - What are the messages we want them to know?
 - What tools are needed to deliver the messages?
- Attended various meetings for personnel issues
- the administration team has taken over all Human Resources job duties
- Discussions with administration regarding student attendance
 - high school attendance is of most concern
 - Every Teacher a Leader (ETaL) group continues to meet to discuss outreach and strategies to get high schoolers to school

 - Student Success: attendance and MAP assessments

 - District Excellence: State report card and balanced dashboard of other priorities
 - Efficient Use of Resources: balanced budget and open enrollment
