Dean of Curriculum and Instruction Monthly Report

Date: January 9, 2023

- The Career Readiness Community of Practice team will be meeting a couple of times in January to continue working on our plan. Stephanie Lewis shared the ACP plan documents with me, which has been helpful. For clarification purposes, ACP and Career Readiness are the same thing.
- The ELA curriculum team continues to review the many samples we have. We are starting to come to more of a consensus as to which ones the K-5 teachers feel will not support our students. The tentative plan is to present to the board in March, but it might not be until April. The final decision will be decided in February.
- The other curriculum teams will be meeting in January and February. The main goal is to create K-12 curriculum maps for each content area. For example, World History 6-12. This will help teachers understand what is taught at each grade level and support them in lesson planning.
- MAP testing window for the Winter assessment opened on January 9th and will close on January 31.
- YRBS will be administered to students in grades 6-12 February 15-16. A letter will be sent to parents. Shellie Swanson shared last year's letter, which is very helpful.
- Cable Natural History Museum will be visiting the K-5 classes for Winter sessions January 30-31. The students and teachers really enjoyed the lessons in the Fall. The lessons for Winter will be:
 - K: Using your senses in Winter (featuring weasels)
 - 1: Bats
 - 2: Scat and Tracks
 - 3: Wolves
 - 4: Loons
 - 5: Fish
- As of today, January 9th I have no PBIS teacher reward nominations. I will remind staff about them in my newsletter.
