Summer work includes

- Hiring teaching staff.
 - K-12 School Counselor (ES and MS focus)
 - K-5 Native American Culture and Language teacher
 - 5th grade teacher at Bayfield Elementary
 - K-5 teacher (.5 FTE) at LaPointe Elementary
- PLC work:
 - Professional Learning Communities at Work Institute in Madison, WI will be attended by Angela Botka (reading specialist/interventionist), Clendon Gustafson (reading specialist/interventionist), and Donna Miller (4th grade teacher). These three will be joining the ES PLC Guiding Coalition.
 - Review- Make It Happen: Coaching With the 4 Critical Questions of PLCs at Work by Kim Bailey and Chris Jakicic
 - Review- Taking Action: A Handbook for RTI at Work by Austin Buffum, Mike Mattos, and Janet Malone

 of instructional time at each grade level as well as providing common planning time for
 grade level teachers. Emphasis on finding time for our 3 interventionists and 3 SPED case
 managers to all be engaged with a grade level on tier 3 interventions.
- Work with the Tech team to complete the field trip and vehicle request form transition from paper to electronic.
- Work with the admin team to finalize our beginning of the year inservice schedule.
- Working with staff who are off during the summer on an as needed basis by phone, email, and in-person meetings.
