  - Other Next steps that will assist Native American Culture teachers:
    - Create Ojibwe Culture and Language Standards for our district.
      - This will create a pathway for resource needs and teacher support needs.
        - Met with Sarah Gordon Altman to invite her to be a part of the standard design team. She will join our group.

- on 12/1 attended a meeting regarding language revitalization with guest speaker, Howard Paden, from the Cherokee Nation
  - Cherokee have prioritized language revitalization
    - have a campus and growing community all focused on learning and using the Cherokee language
- Continued research and discussions with CESA 12 and LCO University on possible partnerships with the Algebra Project.
- Communication with Jacob Kaiser of the RFR-Rec Center
  - to finalize summer programming
  - discuss a walking program run by the Rec Center? and hosted by the school?
