The Fountas and Pinnell report was not available to share at this time. The Dean of Instruction will have it available in March.

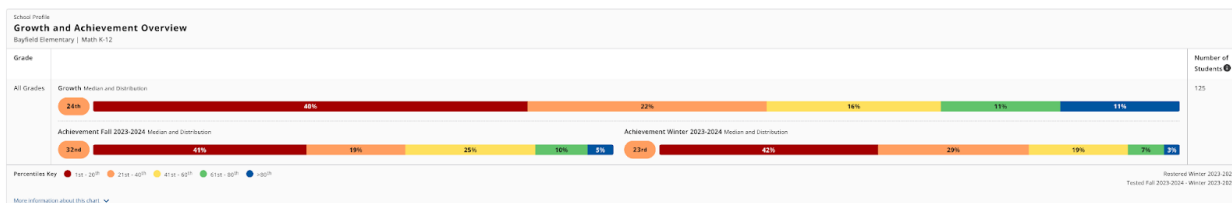
#### 2) NWEA Measures of Academic Progress (MAP)

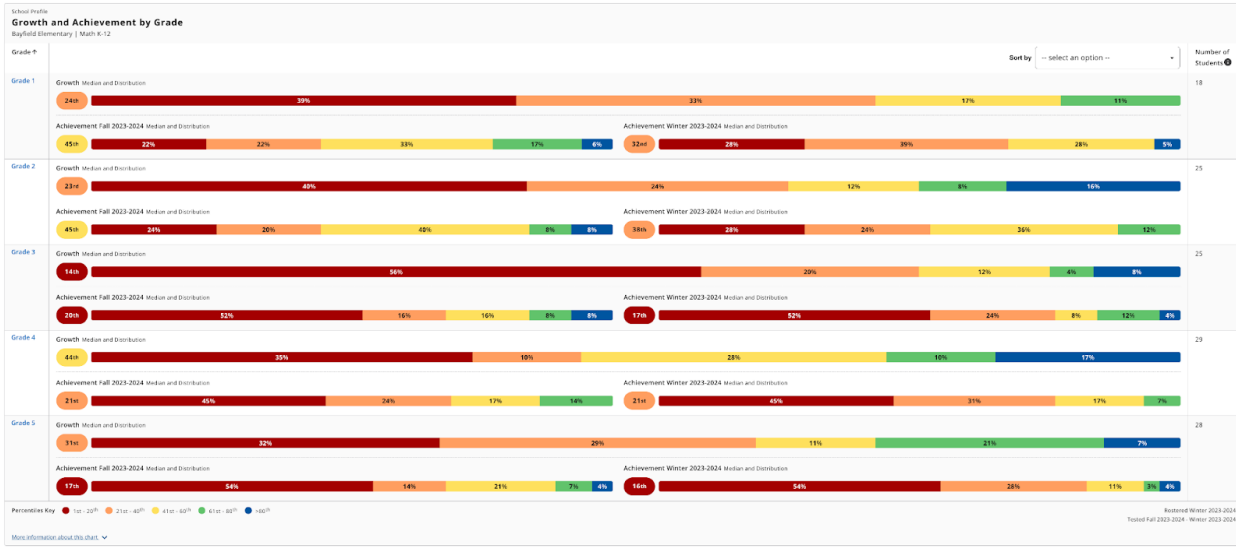

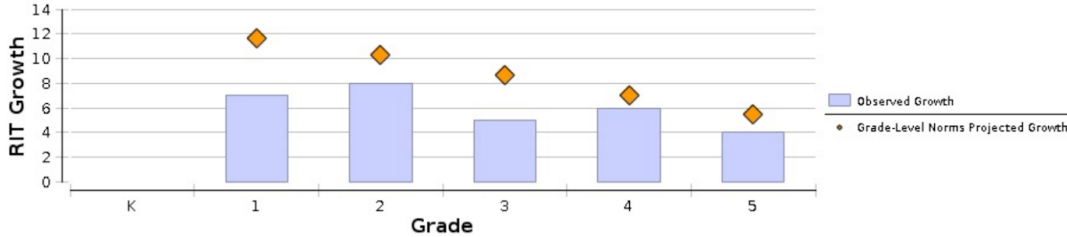

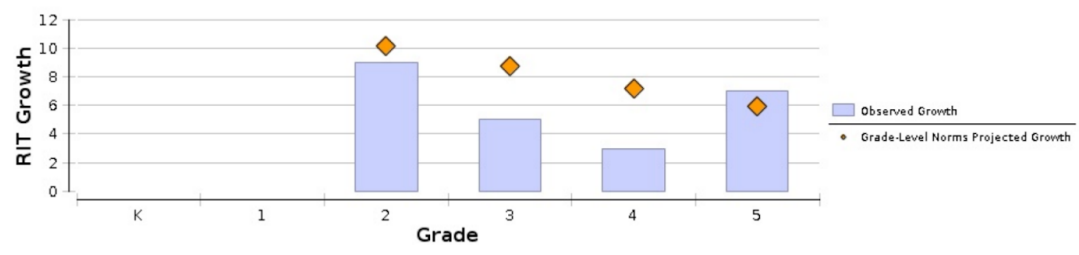
