Dean of Curriculum and Instruction Monthly Report

Date: March 12, 2024

- Forward testing will start the week prior to Spring Break. I have almost completed the prep work for the testing. Elementary staff have completed their schedules. The state requires ELA testing to be completed within the first 3 weeks of the testing window, which is March 18-April 26. Teachers agree doing the ELA before Spring Break is best for students, and I agree. Math (3-8), Science (4th and 8th), and Social Studies (4th, 8th, and 10th) will be completed after Spring Break. - I was not able to get the survey out for our 2023 graduates yet, but will do so the week of the 18th. This data can be used to improve instructional practices, and school policy, and to see where our graduates are. It will also make entering the data into the CTE grad report the state requires.
