District Strategic Priorities of focus this month:

Directives from the October meeting:

Directive: a follow up to the community regarding the community listening sessions that were held in September. A response to the community regarding the information sessions held in September is on the district website. After conferring with Kevin Stranberg, we decided that a letter to the community along with his full summary of the sessions made sense. Especially given that the Community Survey will go out soon.

Directive/action: proceed with the community survey regarding facility need/repair/renovation Survey to print 11/13/24, mailed and online link options open 12/2-23.

Directive: at Policy Committee draft language for guidelines regarding elementary students enrolling at the La Pointe School and/or Bayfield Elementary (mainland) if the student doesn't live in the school location. Policy has a draft and had discussion at the 11/11 committee meeting. More to come.
