It has been an exciting and productive start to the winter athletic season.

Our **elementary basketball partnership with the Red Cliff Boys and Girls Club** is underway for this winter. This collaboration provides an excellent opportunity for our younger students to build foundational skills and experience team play in a supportive environment. A letter will go out to elementary families in mid-November with full details on registration, schedules, and participation expectations.

Our **high school basketball programs** officially began the week of **November 10**, and our **middle school boys' basketball team** is already off to a strong start. We are looking forward to a competitive and spirited winter season across all levels.
