### **Student & Staff Health and Wellbeing:**

Middle/High School staff attendance for January included **50** instances of Frontline absences or need for a sub. This is the single request number, and does not include the two staff out on Maternity/Paternity leave. There were **28.5** days filled for those two positions. For a total of **78.5** instances that we had MS/HS staff out and a possible sub paid to fill-in.

Of those 78.5, the highest was for staff out on Parental Leave at **36%** of the absences. The next highest was for Administrative Leave for interview committees at **20%** of the absences. The third highest absenteeism reason is **15%** were for staff or their family members being ill. **40%** of the 78.5 absences were covered internally, or no coverage was needed.

Student attendance for January did not meet our target for either middle or high school, 90% or higher. High school attendance was **83.29%** for the month, a slight decrease from December. Middle school attendance was **89.7%**, an increase from December's 86.46%. Attendance has improved for both schools compared to last year's first semester numbers. The increase for the semester is **1.23%**. Student Attendance data and charts have been shared below.

Behavior incidents and comparison information have been shared below.

**FINANCE OFFICE INFO:** I signed off on "blue slips" for extra duties/hours provided by staff members in November, for a total of **12.75hours**. Six of these hours were for after hour meetings. And only 2.75 hours were submitted for covering a peer's classroom when a sub wasn't available.

### **Community Collaborations and Partnerships:**

Ski Hill dates have been set up for MS/HS days. A teacher leader from MS and HS will be organizing all of the paperwork. Due to a generous donation from both the JOM committee and staff donations, three of the ski days are covered financially for all MS students.
