Our Winter sports have now come to an end besides some end of the year wrap up. Here is a summary of those sports that have finished.

The High School boys basketball team ended the year 10-15 and 8-10 in conference which put them in the middle of the standings. Two of their players (Adrien Antiel/Soph and Kayden LaGrew/Senior) were honorable mention all-conference. They will be losing a few seniors but return a core of young players who experienced a good amount of varsity time.

The High School girls basketball team ended the year 7-18 and 5-11 in conference which was good for 6th place in the standings. This is the most games a Bayfield girls team has won in quite a few years. We had one player (Stella Gordon/Junior) who made 2nd team all-conference and I look forward to having her back next year. As a freshman she was honorable mention last year she was 3rd team and this year got to 2nd team. We are hoping to cap her senior year with a 1st team selection. We will be losing a couple seniors but return the majority of the squad going into next year.

The Middle School girls volleyball teams ended the year undefeated and boy what a year they had. Tatum and Liv did a wonderful job coaching and teaching around 25 girls through a 14 match schedule. We celebrated their accomplishment on Wednesday with an all school pep rally. Brett and the band played pep music along with our school song, I spoke about the Spring sports and the coaches ended with a couple speeches talking about the growth of the girls. It was a great environment for all to experience.

We have been having monthly meetings and discussions about improving the athletic department and it has been very helpful getting input from different parts of this team. This past month we had a very healthy conversation moving into the Spring. Before Spring Break we will be organizing a Saturday morning soccer program for the elementary inside the gym. Scheduled to start after Spring Break and a flyer will be distributed to these grades. We do have a list of volunteers so I will be reaching out and gaining interest on who is willing to help. I am hoping this program will encourage our youth in joining the well established Washburn youth program.

The athletic handbook has a bit of tweaking to be done to it and the plan is to present this at the April meeting. After working our home games through the Winter months I would also like to make a few changes to attendance at these events when not in school and disciplining students when something arises at these events so we can reduce these problems.

As for the Spring sports I have had sign up sheets by my office for the past month and the numbers are great. The HS track team started practice with Michael on the 9th and he has about 15 athletes. HS baseball starts on the 23rd and Brett currently has 13 athletes signed up. MS track starts April 6th and currently the list has 10 students signed up.

Personally I am already in the process of setting up schedules for next year and having conversations still with Washburn about co-oping in sports we do not offer here in Bayfield. I know there is an interest however not the sort of interest to offer them here at Bayfield. A transition like this would take a few years because the last thing I would like to do is add another sport and have issues in keeping it going. This is a start with getting numbers for

future thoughts. I have been very busy getting this Troller program back to where I and you think we need to be for our students, their families and the Troller community.
