4. Strategic Planning: Discussion. Summary attached.

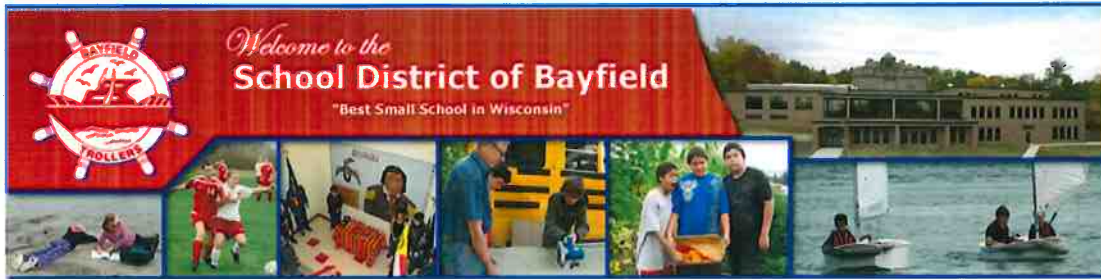
