SCHOOL ATTORNEY

The Board of Education may retain an attorney to act as legal counsel for the Board and the Administration.

Legal advice shall be obtained through the District Administrator, unless otherwise specified by the Board.

This policy does not limit school officials from contacting sources other than the District's legal counsel for general legal assistance. For example, the Department of Public Instruction or the Wisconsin Association of School Boards are alternate sources for legal opinion, advice or recommendations.
