BOARD MEMBER AUTHORITY

Members of the Board of Education have authority only when acting as a Board legally in session. Members, as individuals, do not possess the corporate powers of the Board.

The goals of the educational system can only be met with the Board functioning as a team, not as individuals.

The Board shall not be bound in any way by any action or statement on the part of any individual Board member, except when such statement or action is in pursuance of specific instructions from the Board.
