ADVISORY COMMITTEES TO THE BOARD

The Board of Education recognizes the invaluable assistance which can be gained for the entire school district from citizens, students and staff through their input and cooperation.

Therefore, committees may be appointed to serve in an advisory capacity to the Board. Advisory committees may contribute to the educational program by conducting studies, identifying problems and developing recommendations to enhance the effectiveness of the decision-making process.

The Board may appoint members to an advisory committee by any means it feels will be effective and advantageous to the District. The Board shall have sole power to dissolve any of its advisory committees and shall reserve the right to exercise this power at any time during the life of any committee.

Advisory committees are advisory and, as such, have no power to act for the Board. The Board reserves the right to exercise its legal duty to use judgment in all matters of decision making. Individuals participating on an advisory committee shall recognize the Board's responsibilities.
