ADMINISTRATION TEAM GOALS

The administration of the School District of Bayfield is responsible for the direction, coordination and oversight of students and staff in their efforts to reach educational goals established by the Board of Education. The District Administrator shall be the chief executive officer of the School District. Responsibility shall flow clearly from the District Administrator through the administrative staff to the operational personnel. Administrators should demonstrate leadership and be able to resolve challenges which arise within the school system and in its relations with the community.

The Board expects the administration to:

1. Identify issues and needs in the District;
2. Specialize in the processes of decision making and communication;
3. Plan, organize, implement and evaluate the District's educational program;
4. Coordinate and guide the various centers of power within the school system and the community so as to enable people to do things together for education that they might never be able to do separately; and
5. Be sensitive to cultural needs and differences.
