The Board of Education feels that professional growth of administrators is desirable and necessary to maintain competence in school administration. Therefore, the Board encourages administrators to attend educational meetings, conferences and workshops in order to become aware of changes in education that may affect school district policies and programs.

The District Administrator may attend those meetings within the State of Wisconsin considered to be of benefit to the School District of Bayfield. Expenses shall be reimbursed in accordance with established procedures. Meetings at the United States Office of Education in Washington, Regional Office in Chicago, and the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) Office in Minneapolis may be attended. Other out of state educational meetings, conferences and workshops may be attended with Board approval.
