

SCHOOL DISTRICT OF BAYFIELD
PROGRAMS FOR CHILDREN AT RISK

The District Administrator, or designee, shall develop a plan for children in the School District of Bayfield who are identified at risk in accordance with state statutes.

The children at risk program shall be designed to:

- a. Improve and expand educational opportunities for these children on an individualized basis, through a variety of means (e.g. remedial instruction);
- b. Provide alternative courses or program modifications which satisfactorily meet the District's graduation requirements;
- c. Encourage parental involvement; and
- d. Encourage cooperation with community support service agencies.

Students shall be identified and referred to the program in accordance with state regulations and guidelines established by the administration. An annual report concerning children at risk shall be made to the Department of Public Instruction.
