The Board is committed to the pursuit of academic excellence and the intellectual development of each student. All staff are strongly encouraged to support and challenge all learners. Students who exhibit the ability and motivation to pursue more challenging coursework will be given opportunities for acceleration in whatever form best serves the individual student.

The extent and depth of acceleration will be determined following completion of a thorough assessment of the student's academic ability and a meeting with parents, teacher(s), principal and/or school psychologist and guidance counselor. Acceleration requires joint approval of parents and the principal.
