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GUIDANCE AND COUNSELING PROGRAM

The School District of Bayfield shall provide a program of guidance and counseling services in grades kindergarten through 12. Specific goals of the guidance and counseling program shall be as follows:

- 1.To help students in developing a knowledge of self including aptitudes, abilities, needs, values, interests, strengths, limitations and self-worth.
- 2.To assist students with emotional growth, including family relationships and the understanding of others.
- 3.To assist students in the development of social skills and civic responsibilities.
- 4.To assist students with problem-solving, decision-making and coping skills.
- 5.To help students with educational development including basic skills.
- 6.To form partnerships between school and community designed to assist students in their career development.
- 7.To assist staff as a resource in student/teacher relationships, behavior management, student evaluation and parent contacts.
- 8.To provide assistance to students and families during crisis situations.

The School District of Bayfield shall not discriminate in the methods, practices and materials used for counseling, testing or evaluating students on the basis of sex, race, national origin, color, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, religion, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability or handicap. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established complaint procedures.
