EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

The extracurricular activities program in the School District of Bayfield is recognized as a valuable aspect of the total educational program. The Board of Education feels an extracurricular activities program, properly operated, provides experience in daily human relations which cannot be found in any other educational context.

The School District of Bayfield offers extracurricular activities for its students as part of the educational experience provided at school. As participants in these activities, students should serve as models of good citizenship and respectable behavior which the school system seeks to promote. Hence, all Bayfield students who participate have a responsibility to their parents/guardians, their school and themselves to conduct themselves in an exemplary manner and in accordance with the standards set forth in the District's school activity code.

The Board of Education shall provide access to and encourage the full participation in extracurricular and recreational activities and programs by students in grades K-8. For purposes of Board policy, "full participation" means fair and equal participation to the extent that the budget, facilities or type of activity allows.

The School District of Bayfield shall not discriminate in admission to any program or activity, standards and rules of behavior, disciplinary actions or facilities usage on the basis of sex, race, national origin, ancestry, color, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, religion, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability or handicap. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
