STUDENT FUNDRAISING ACTIVITIES

The Board of Education recognizes the interest of school classes and organizations in fundraising projects to support activities. These activities may include, but are not restricted to, class trips, music trips, bowling, skiing and Homecoming.

While the Board is supportive of class or organization activities, it is also cognizant of the impact of fund raising within communities. The following procedures apply to any fundraising activity. Fund raising activities must have prior Principal approval. Instructional time is not to be used for fundraising. There will be no direct solicitation of money for groups or clubs, or door to door selling. No commitment to a vendor is allowed until permission from the Principal is granted. Additionally, students cannot be restricted from activities or group rewards because of participation or non-participation in fund raising.
