

**SCHOOL DISTRICT OF BAYFIELD****NURSING SERVICES**

Nursing services shall be provided in the School District of Bayfield in accordance with state laws and regulations. The objective of nursing services is the maintenance of the physical, mental, and emotional health of pupils while they are at school or participating in school activities.

Nursing services shall be provided for all pupils under the leadership and supervision of a registered nurse. Arrangements shall be made with a physician to serve as medical advisor for emergency nursing services.

Emergency nursing services shall be available during the regular school day and during co-curricular activities. The district may contact 911 to provide emergency health services and transportation at the expense of the pupil's parent/guardian.

Equipment and supplies for emergency nursing services shall be readily accessible. First aid kits shall be available in the school and on the school buses. An Automated External Defibrillator (AED) shall be available in the School District of Bayfield K-12 school building.

The District Administrator will designate a person to maintain a record keeping system in regard to emergency nursing services and to notify parents of illness or injury.
