GUIDELINES FOR SELECTING ACADEMIC
EXCELLENCE HIGHER EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP

The Board of Education shall select the District's recipient of the Wisconsin Academic Excellence Higher Education Scholarship by February 15th each year. The recipient will be the senior with the highest grade point average.

At the February Board meeting, the high school principal will give to the Board, in executive session, the name of the student with the highest grade point average. Should there be a tie of two or more students, the Board will instruct the principal to have the five member scholarship selection committee meet for the purpose of recommending the student it feels is most deserving. The scholarship selection committee will take into account the following:

- attendance
- punctuality
- national test scores
- school involvement (forensics, music and athletics)
- leadership involvement (class offices held, Student Council and National Honor Society)
- community service

The Board will make the final selection.
