STUDENT FEE WAIVER AND REDUCTION PROCEDURES

The Board recognizes that while certain fees charged students are appropriate and authorized, certain students and their families are not financially able to pay the fees. The School District of Bayfield will grant full waivers, partial waivers, or temporary waivers depending upon the circumstances and the student's or parent/guardian's ability to meet the financial criteria. Waivers issued are for that school year only.

Student fines or charges assessed for damage or loss to school property are not fees as that term is used in these procedures, and will not be waived in accordance with these procedures.

A student will be granted a **full waiver** of fees (with the exception of driver's education) charged by the District if the student has been deemed eligible for free meal status under the District's National School Lunch Program.

A student will be granted a **partial waiver** of fees (with the exception of driver's education) charged by the District if the student has been deemed eligible for reduced-price meal status under the District's National School Lunch Program. The amount of the partial waiver shall be based on the percentage of reduced-price to full-priced lunch in the District, but no less than the price of a reduced meal.
