The bins are then carted away to Ashland, to be put in a machine that will turn the scraps into soil. Unfortunately, some students do not take the time to separate their plastic cups from the compost.

According to owner and operator Jamie Tucker, this is bad for the soil. "Plastics harm the organisms in our soil which is where our compost goes. This is why it's important to make sure we do not mix our compostables with plastic. We sell our compost back to local farmers and gardeners to help their soil in a healthy way." This includes Bayfield school garden, which grows a lot of the vegetables Bayfield students eat. It takes very little effort to separate plastic from food and since Bayfield are the ones eating food from the school garden, it makes sense to toss the plastic before composting.
